

Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education

All schools must, by law, provide a 'broad and balanced curriculum' that 'prepares young people for the opportunities and responsibilities of adult life'. At WSA, we recognise that PSHE lessons make a significant contribution to the fulfillment of this requirement.

Although it is a non-statutory subject, all schools are expected to teach PSHE as outlined in the National Curriculum. Through our curriculum, our children are equipped with the knowledge and skills necessary to make safe and informed decisions about issues which may impact on their daily lives, such as keeping themselves safe, drugs, finance, sex and relationships, physical activity and diet. To help deliver current and appropriate information the school has embraced the Police Investments in Primary School scheme offered by Humberside Police and have a nominated officer who works directly in school.
