Consequently, our pupils receive their Sex and Relationships education in the wider context of relationships, so that all are prepared for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of adult life.

Our children are encouraged, from entering the Foundation Stage through to Year 6, to show care and respect for themselves and each other. A programme of support to develop these skills is in place, annually provided by Big Talk Education.
